Summary: <p>The traditional approach to the delivery of E-Assessment is to run the assessments in the University's computer labs. However, the number of computers is limited and the University needs continuous investment into hardware. Therefore, to make e-Assessment more scalable (for student numbers up to 1000 students), new approaches to delivery are needed.</p> <p>This session will look into new ways to deliver e-Assessment by exploring the new concepts of mobile installation of laptops and the use of student laptops for the assessment process.</p>
