Edumatic is an online tool for creating/authoring exercises and questions and publish them as exercises or assessments (tests or exams). User management is handled by a Single Sign On web service, allowing you to plug Edumatic into your existing e-learning environment (like Moodle, Bb, Dokeos, Fronter...). Another way of publishing is through SCORM compliant packages that can be imported into all e-learning environments. Additionally, you can also distribute and use a standalone version of the published items. This workshop will show (and let you work with) the basics of creating items, selecting and combining items into an assessment (including filtering on adaptive metadata) and reviewing the student's results in the Reporting area. The import of SCORM packages into VLE's will also be demonstrated and tested by the participants. Edumatic has many options for adding feedback to your questions and adding (simple or sophisticated) scores. Some of the correction types of Edumatic are really innovative and high performing.
