Summary: <p>We have been moving towards accessible and inclusive assessment and e-assessment for several years now. Certain features are becoming more common but are still not ubiquitous (e.g. user control over font and colour; equivalent paper alternatives to e-assessments where appropriate), and we are still a long way from e-assessment processes routinely posing few barriers to learners with particular needs. So what is still getting in the way of Inclusive e-Assessment? This session will pose some suggestions based on user experiences from the different sectors of education, and delegates will be expected to add their suggestions. Actions for tackling some of the barriers will be discussed.</p>
