Summary: <p>As e-assessment is developing rapidly, there is need for development of frameworks to aid such systems' development. Design Methodology Management (DMM) technology can be useful in that respect. DMM has mostly been applied to the field of electrical computer aided design but it can potentially be used in other fields of design such as software and mechanical design. In this paper we present an overview of e-assessment as a domain of e-learning, and investigate the potential of applying DMM in the development of e-assessment systems based on a case study of e-assessment system requirements for collaborative work on the subject area of Data Analysis.</p>
